As Outreach & Education Team Lead, Brett has co-developed and presented the MCAT presentations “Making Our Homes Safer, Cleaner and Greener” — a primer about methane in our homes, and also an overview of Executive Order 20-04, the Oregon Climate Action Plan. He grew up in Texas and Seattle. During 27 years at TriMet he developed transit software and managed TriMet's Database group, where his group designed and built many of the agency's backend systems. A school funding activist from 1996-2006, he was heavily involved in the 1999 campaign for Portland Measure 26-2, which brought \$78M in emergency funding to Portland Public Schools. In earlier incarnations Brett worked in multiple occupations in Austin, Anchorage and San Francisco.
